As they filed out of my office, many of them apologized for doubting my word earlier in the day. A lot of the students thanked me for showing them the information and the accompanying videos.

One girl came up to me, after the other students had gone back to their dormitories, and was on the verge of tears. I told her not to cry and that it was best to know the truth, even though it was as shocking as it was.

Then tears rolled down her cheeks and she said she was very angry. I tried to console her but she would have none of it.

Then she literally shocked me when she said, “But I am really angry that I had to learn *my* own history from a *foreigner*.”

Needless to say, I waited until I got out of China to finish the book.

It was not until later, while talking with other teachers, that I discovered how the Director had found out about my book.

I had casually (naively) spoken about my book in class and simply got caught. I never did find out who the student spy was.

## **JUDY LEE – THE CHRISTIAN**
